

# NOTICE OF RACE

September 7-9 2007

## Mumm 30 One Design Regatta

**Organized by Sail Newport, Newport RI,  
Mumm 30 National and East Coast Circuit Series Regatta**

- RULES** The regatta will be governed by the "rules" as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*. Each boat must be equipped with a VHF radio capable of transmitting and receiving on channel 05.
- ELIGIBILITY** Open to Mumm 30 Class. To constitute a regatta 6 boats must be registered by August 31, 2007
- ENTRIES** Eligible boats may enter by completing the official Entry Form available at [www.sailnewport.org](http://www.sailnewport.org) and paying all fees, through August 31<sup>st</sup>. Late entries, which include a \$50 late fee, will be accepted through September 5th.
- ENTRY FEE** The entry fee is \$150 per boat. Socials will be held at a separate venue, and organized by the Class. Fees for socials will be assessed separately and collected from the class.
- INSTRUCTIONS** Sailing Instructions will be available at [www.sailnewport.org](http://www.sailnewport.org), and at Sail Newport the day of registration.
- SCHEDULE** The number of races will be determined by the race committee. The first warning signal is scheduled for 1100 each day. No warning signal will be made after 1500 on Sunday.
- RACE AREA** Races will be sailed on Rhode Island Sound and/ or Narragansett Bay.
- COURSES** Courses will be windward/leeward, as described in the Sailing Instructions
- PENALTY SYSTEM** Rule 44.2 is modified to a One-Turn Penalty when not within two lengths of a mark.
- SCORING** The Low Point Scoring System of Appendix A will apply. There will be no throw out.
- PRIZES** Regatta prizes will be awarded.
- LAUNCH AND HAUL** The Launch, Haul and Dockage Fee for each boat using the Sail Newport Hoist is: \$120. Dockage Fee for Mumm 30's not using the Sail Newport Hoist have a Dockage Fee of \$60.

## ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

For the Mumm 30 Class only, the following provisions will apply in order for the event to qualify as part of the 2007 Mumm 30 National and East Coast Circuit Series:

### Entries / Registration

In addition to submitting the online entry form to Sail Newport, all Mumm 30 class competitors must complete the following with the class office no later than May 29, 2007:

a) Owner, Charterer, and alternate helmsman Mumm 30 Class Membership Dues for 2007 paid and on file with Staggy Yachts

b) Crew classification declared and verified on the Sail/Crew Declaration form

And must complete the following with the on site class representative no later than 0900 on September 5th, 2007:

a) Skipper and crew weighing complete and liability waivers signed and on file

b) Sail Declaration form on file

c) All owners, tacticians and boat captains shall be required to sign Appendix 6 of the Mumm 30 Class Rules stating that their boat fully complies with Class Rules and that they will abide by said Class Rules while racing

For the event to qualify as part of the 2007 Mumm 30 National and East Coast Circuit four races must be completed.
